***Resolution of Appreciation
To
Donald Y. Milne***

WHEREAS, Donald Y. Milne was appointed to the Board of Trustees of the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy by the City Council of Sandy City in October 2006 and was reappointed to serve four additional terms through September 2024, only weeks before his passing; and

WHEREAS, Donald Milne utilized his education, training, unique seismic expertise in California, and vast experience in public institutions and entities to aid and assist this District in fulfilling its responsibilities in efficiently and effectively providing a clean, safe and dependable water supply to its member cities and contract purchasers and their inhabitants at reasonable rates and charges; and

WHEREAS, Donald Milne served as a member of the Engineering Committee during his entire tenure on the Board, contributing knowledge and experience as a Professional Civil Engineer since 1958, active duty in the U.S. Air Force and Air Force Reserves for twenty-eight years, and a long and meaningful career at Los Angeles County; and

WHEREAS, in his role on the Executive Committee, Engineering Committee, and Board, Don played an essential role in protecting District's right-of-way, facilities and property rights and oversight of the Terminal Reservoir Replacement Project, Managed Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project, and the District's capital improvement program; and

WHEREAS, among other activities Donald Milne served on the Board of Directors of the Provo River Water Users Association Board for more than sixteen years, the Sandy City Planning Commission for ten years, and the Sandy City Public Utilities Advisory Board for eighteen years; and

WHEREAS, Donald has been recognized for his commitment and service to his community, including as Outstanding Citizen Volunteer in 1998, Outstanding Volunteer of the Year in 1999, Key to the City in 2002, Parks and Recreation Volunteer of the Year in 2004, and Noel Bateman Recipient in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Donald Milne was always prepared, punctual, kind, and professional. He was an example, dear friend, and mentor to many District staff; and

WHEREAS, Donald Milne devoted over seven years to the daily feeding and care of his wife Renée in a care facility while still fulfilling all of his duties and responsibilities as a member of the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy hereby expresses its deepest gratitude to Donald Milne for his many contributions to the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy, and for his dedication with excellence to its goals and purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be made a part of the permanent records of this District, such that those who follow might know of Donald's contribution to the District, and that a copy of this Resolution be presented to his daughters, Michelle King and Alicia Tebbs, that they and his family may know and remember the District's gratitude for his service.
